EHF Video School in KIEV

European Headache School took place in Kiev on the 19th of May 2012, for the second time in Ukraine. One day video course was held for 60 doctors of different specialties – neurologists, general physicians, neurosurgeons, clinical pharmacologists and health professionals. The conference was opened with welcome notes of Professor Fabio Antonaci (University Consortium for Adaptive Disorders and Head pain (UCADH), Headache Medicine Centre (Pavia, Italy), who was the initiator of holding the video course, together with Dr. Tatiana Maykova (Headache Center Kiev, Dnepropetrovsk, Ukraine). Fabio Antonaci led the work of the conference. Conference program was intensive – 13 video lectures concerned key issues in classification, diagnostics, clinical aspects and treatment of migraine and trigeminal autonomic cephalalgias. Live lecture “Diagnostic and therapeutic errors in headache disorders” delivered by professor Antonaci provoked great interest. During several discussion sessions Professor Antonaci answered numerous key questions. Organizer from Ukrainian side was Tatiana Maykova (Headache Center Kiev, Dnepropetrovsk, Ukraine). Actavis, PharmaStart and Sun Pharma were sponsors of the event. European Headache School appeared to be a great event for Ukraine. Ukrainian doctors hope for continuing of this educational program.

The Italian Society for the Study of Headaches (SISC) announces the competition of the biennial Enrico Greppi Award 2012. The award will be granted to the best unpublished original paper dealing with clinical, epidemiological, genetic, pathophysiological or therapeutic aspects of headache. The prize amounts to € 10,000 and is open to researchers of all nationalities. The papers must be submitted in accordance with the editorial instructions of The Journal of Headache and Pain. The winning article will be

published ex officio in The Journal of Headache and Pain within three months of the Award presentation. The remaining papers are considered as submitted to The Journal of Headache and Pain and may be published after undergoing the peer-reviewing process. The Award is endorsed by the European Headache Federation (EHF) and the winner is invited to present the paper at the 3rd European Headache and Migraine Trust International Congress 2012 (EHMTIC), to be held in London, UK on 20-23 September 2012.

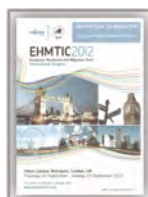

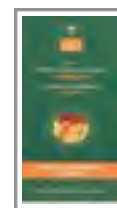
